During September and October, our office has fielded many calls from clients who believe they have just spoken with a representative from the IRS. The call usually goes something like this: According to our records, you owe taxes. We need you to make an immediate payment or the Sheriff will arrest you. They then ask for a social security number and/or payment information.

**This is a Scam.**

The IRS will never call or email you out of the blue. You will first receive a letter, or several letters, before the IRS acts by sending an agent.

Please tell your elderly family members about this scam, as they are a favored target.
